I REMEMBER WHEN: *The St. Michael's Annual Picnic by Sandra (Nabuda) Fisher*

Everyone looked forward to the month of August, when the annual St. Michael's picnic was held. The years were 1970 – 1980's. Tents were set up on the parking lot grounds, and the old hall had all the food and beverages. The Sisterhood handled the food: pierogi, stuffed cabbage dinners, kielbasa and sauerkraut, sloppy joes, side dishes, and a dessert table full of delicious sweets. The women worked in the kitchen for hours serving the food. Dale Martin was in charge of the 50/50 raffle and would have the younger smiling kids as salespeople. There would be games set up in the hall for the kids. Two favorite games were Go fish – where the kids had a fishing pole and would grab a prize; and the Sucker game - where they could pick a candy sucker that was color coded for a prize. The men would sit around the tables under the tents and drink beer and talk about *"the good ole days"*. Sometimes there would be an accordion player or other music. Everyone enjoyed the picnic so much, that when dusk came, it was hard for people to leave.
